(Pay It Forward & Night School)
2009-2010

Pay It Forward (9th Period) – If a student has less than 75% of an assignment complete, they will be assigned to Pay It Forward. It will be mandatory for the student to *stay that day* from 2:50 to 3:30. Students will work on the next day's assignment and turn in that days late work.

Time: 2:50-3:30

Days of the week – Monday – Friday

Bus Transportation – 4:15 – Monday - Friday

Drop-off locations: Springhill - 158th & Rosewood, Rockcreek Apts., Stoneybrook South – Fire station, Rockwell Elem., Bryan Elem., Colonies – 148th & Hillsdale, Meadowbrook Estates – Clubhouse, Giles Ridge and Chalco Pointe.

*It will be the **student's responsibility** to contact parents to tell them they are staying after school that day for Pay It Forward. This can be done during the class period they have the incomplete assignment for, during lunch time or between classes.*

Students that stay for Pay It Forward will only have a deduction of **10 % or less** from their late assignment.

Night School – Students are assigned to this program if they have 3 or more Pay It Forwards in one week. It runs from 2:50 – 4:15, Monday – Thursday. Teachers will focus on organizing the student so they can stay on top of their homework assignments. Students are also assigned to Night School for skipping Pay It Forward.

Frequently Asked Questions About Pay It Forward:

How many assignments not completed in one day will result in going to Pay It Forward?

Minimum 1 – assignment for a class period. (less than 75% of one assignment completed)

What if the student completes the late assignment(s) in study hall?

This will be the student's goal during Studyhall. The student will take the late assignment with them to Pay It Forward. During this time the student will work on the next day's assignment and turn in their late work for a minimal deduction in grade.

What if the student turns in poor quality work during class?

Will result in attending Pay It Forward based on teacher decision. Other options: possible grade deduction, natural consequence – lower grade.

Where do bus riders go until the 4:15 bus arrives?

Students report to Academy or Adventure (Information Center) – an announcement will be made each day that the 4:15 bus is here.

What if the student has an after school away game?

Students will be assigned to Pay It Forward for the next day.

Are there extra copies of assignments?

Teachers will have extra copies available in the Team Area.

What if a student does not turn in their incomplete assignment(s) during Pay It Forward?

The student takes any incomplete assignment home to complete. The student is **NOT** assigned to Pay It Forward for the next day.

What if a student is called out early or goes home sick, and they were assigned to Pay It Forward?

The student misses the opportunity to attend Pay It Forward. The student is **NOT** assigned to Pay It Forward for the next day.

What if a student was suppose to stay for Pay It Forward but does not make it?

The student will be referred to Mr. Raabe or Mr. Weber. This counts as a skip and parents will be notified. Consequences will be given for continual skips (Night School, Detention, etc...)
